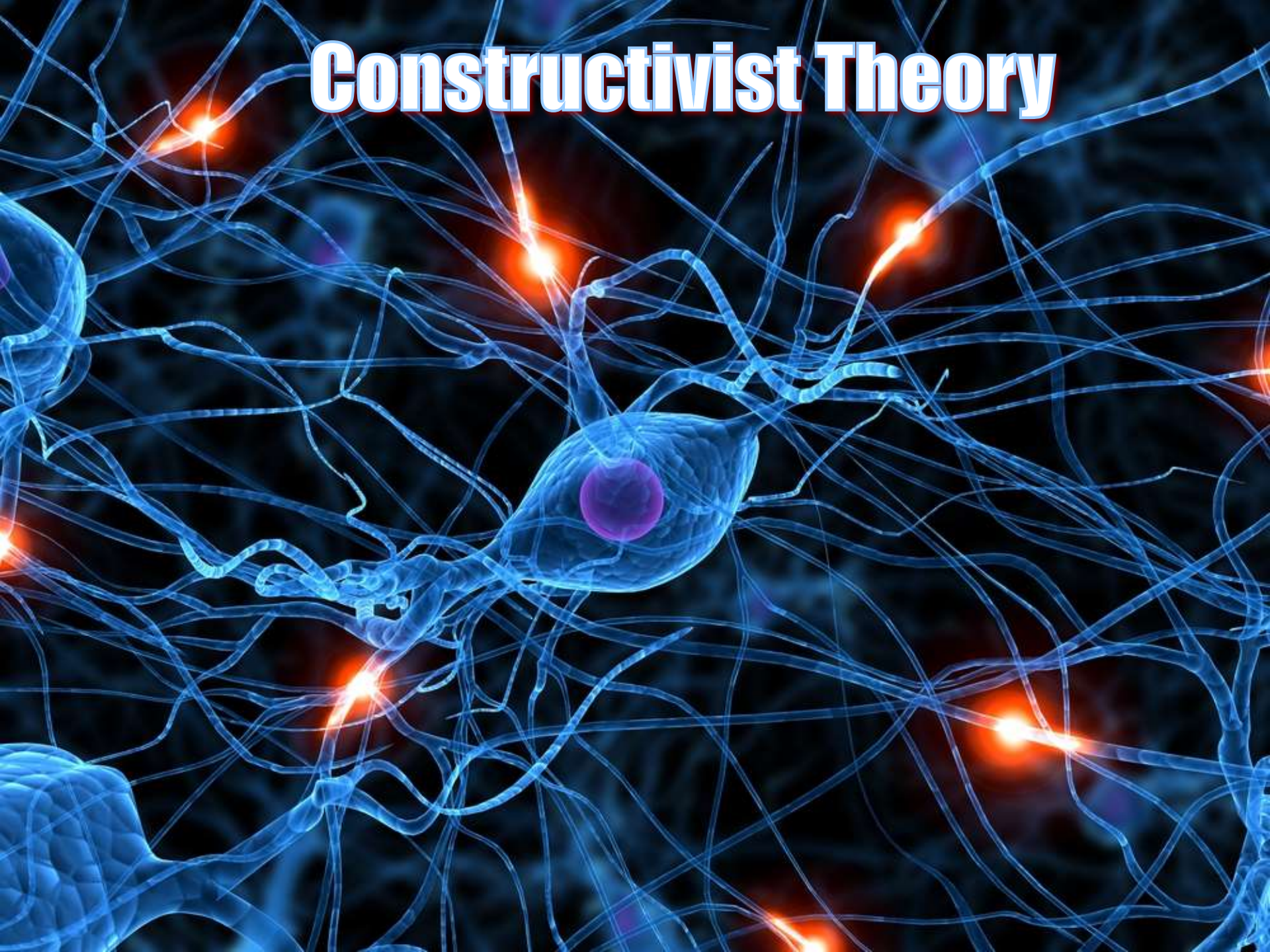

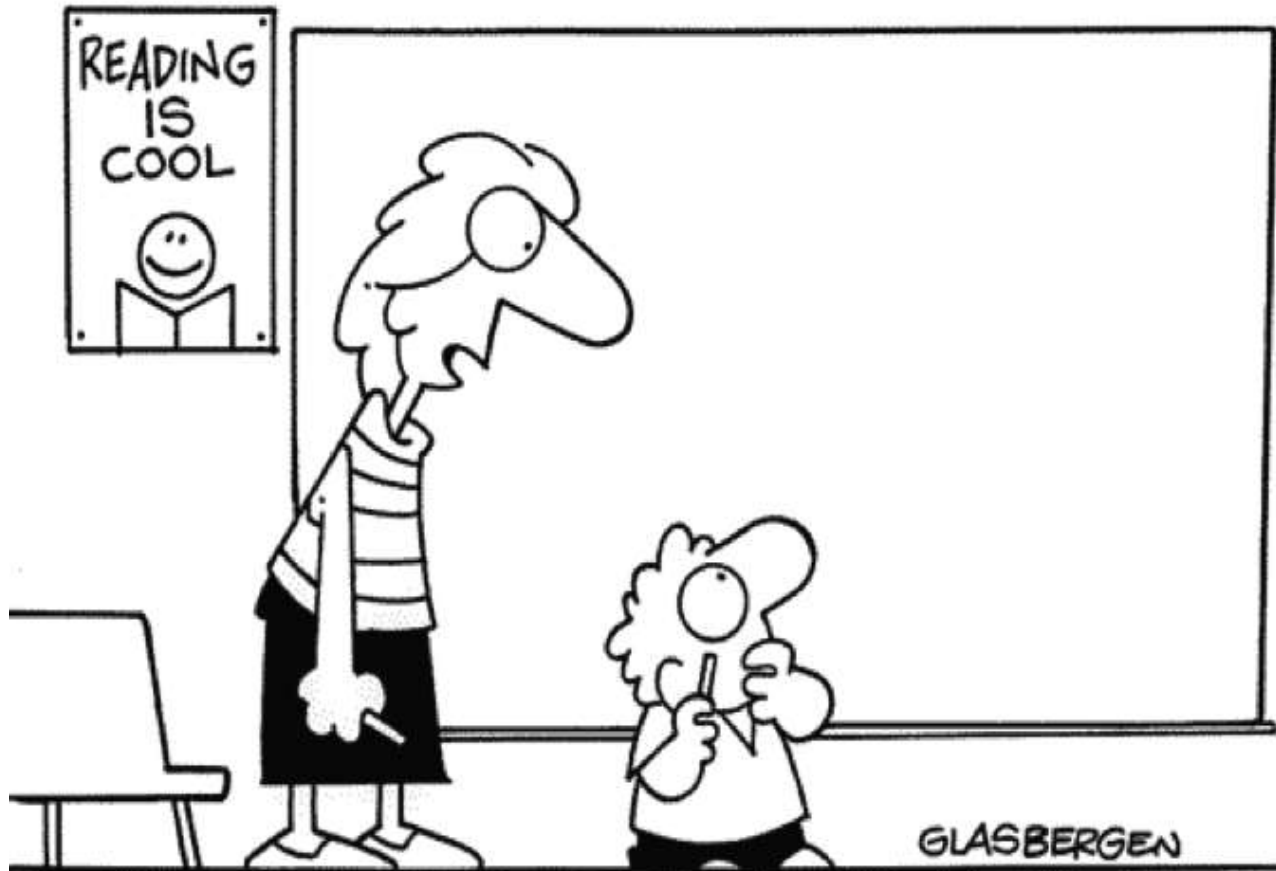

Getting Started

Weebly Address:

Stage 1: Develop a Classroom/School/Collaborative Weebly site

Stage 2: Set Permissions for participants to use the site. They will receive an email letting them know. Click on link sent in email.

Stage 3: Determine essential agreements for quality control and distribute for consensus and feedback

Stage 4: Set permissions for all colleagues and members of the pedagogical leadership team. They will receive an email letting them know. Click on link sent in email.

Stage 5: Identify techies in each team and work in teams to make sure everyone is comfortable using the Weebly. Mini PLC/Drag and Drop

Stage 6: Inform colleagues, parents, and students through newsletters, and launch weebly.



Essential Agreements: Getting Started

1. Student pictures permission form: It is not allowed to post any pictures of students without the express written permission from a parent
2. Password protected
3. Copyright issues: Don't post without citations and permissions – publishing 10% of a book for academic purposes is allowed.
4. Don't share program access codes online
5. Ensure that documents accurately reflect the school adopted policies as well as IB standards and practices
6. For security purposes, only accounts using official emails will be given access to the weebly

Essential Agreements

1. What should be on the weebly? What goes where?

1. What will it need to be?

- **Simple:** Language for parents and students. For example, everyone needs to know what the criteria and rubrics are.
Clear: Use bullet points with clear headings. File names should reflect content.
- **Manageable:** No teacher should spend more than ten minutes each day updating the weebly.
- **Ethical:** All sources used in the development of worksheets, activities etc. need to be cited in MLA format. See citationmachine.net for the short cut for this. What we want from our students we need to model as well.
- **Aligned:** Everything uploaded should align with the mission statement of the school as well as its policies.
