Priorities for IT Spending

Priority	Description
A. IT Infrastructure	Any items needed to maintain the security of data and the efficient operation of the network.
	Examples: servers, cabling, switches, back-up resources, server UPS.
B. Student Learning	Items that directly or indirectly enhance student learning.
	Examples: desktop computers for computer labs, netbooks, software used by students, digital cameras.
C. Staff Tools	Items that are used by BIS staff to do their jobs.
	Examples: Business Office desktop computers, teachers' laptops, school administration software, grading or reporting software, printers.
D.	Things that would do a similar job to IT resources already in the school.
Replacement IT	Examples: A newer version of a digital camera, software updates.
E. Wish List	Items that would be nice to have but are not totally essential for student learning or administration of BIS.
	Examples: Flat screen TV to use as a digital noticeboard, dual monitors.

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
